

IMPACT BY THE NUMBERS FOR DELAWARE

Grants to Delaware Organizations and Individuals from Fiscal Years 2019 through 2023 – \$8.169.985

Total Number of Awards – 32

Award Highlights:

- The University of Delaware will provide six stipends per year for three years for students in the Winterthur/University of Delaware Program in Art Conservation. These NEH Fellows will also have additional outreach and community engagement responsibilities.
- Professor Deborah Steinberger at University of Delaware is researching and translating four early modern French periodical stories from Le Mercure Galant. She will also develop a translation apparatus for the anthology.

NEH also provides annual funding to <u>Delaware Humanities</u>, the designated humanities council in the state, to support a wide array of public programming.

Recent Delaware Humanities Highlights:

- "The Voices of Delaware's Black History." a videos series exploring the stories of four Black Delawareans, premiered on WHYY-PBS, was screened at Greater Harrington Museum, and was distributed to schools statewide. The WHYY videos were aired combined total of 161 times, to a viewership of 2,293,992 people.
- "Let's Talk About Environmental Justice" is a DIY program toolkit that allows host organizations
 to educate audiences on how environmental harms and inequalities affect Delaware
 communities. 50 toolkits featuring background information, a PowerPoint presentation and
 discussion guide, an activity, and a resource list, are being distributed to community
 organizations across Delaware.
