

IMPACT BY THE NUMBERS FOR MISSOURI

Grants to Missouri Organizations and Individuals for Fiscal Year 2019 through 2023 – \$ 13,613,502

Total Number of Awards – 68

Award Highlights:

- Funding was provided to the University of Missouri, Columbia to create and edit the book's manuscript, which would explore the influence of inexpensive paper on Christian devotional activities in medieval Western Europe.
- The University of Missouri's curators have been awarded funding to begin a one-year faculty and curriculum development initiative aimed at developing an interdisciplinary minor in disability studies.

NEH also provides annual funding to the <u>Missouri Humanities</u> Council, the designated humanities council in the state, to support a wide array of public programming.

Recent Missouri Humanities Highlights:

- Missouri Humanities partners with organizations to provide active military personnel, veterans, and their families with an outlet for self-expression through writing. Our Veterans Programs offer support to both new and experienced writers in telling their stories in workshops, readings, podcasts, and in our annual publication, *Proud to Be: Writing By American Warriors*.
- Humanities TV (H-Tv) is a curated collection of films, docu-series, and other digital content to connect viewers with stories, people, and places rooted in the humanities. In the Small Town Showcase series, we strive to highlight the uniqueness of rural Missouri through podcast episodes and short videos.
