

IMPACT BY THE NUMBERS FOR PUERTO RICO

Grants to Puerto Rico Organizations and Individuals from Fiscal Years 2019 through 2023 – \$8,089,084

Total Number of Awards - 48

Award Highlights:

- The University of Puerto Rico, Cayey University College, received an NEH grant to record oral histories with three community-based organizations to document and explore community response and resilience after hurricanes and other climate-related disasters.
- The University of Puerto Rico, Mayaguez, received an NEH grant to create a new undergraduate certificate in media studies that focuses on the themes of power and representation.

NEH also provides annual funding to <u>Fundación Puertorriqueña de las Humanidades</u> (FPH), the designated humanities council in the jurisdiction, to support a wide array of public programming.

Recent FPH Highlights:

- Escenas: Radiografías artísticas de manifestaciones de violencia y de paz.* This series of workshops trains educators, managers, and community facilitators in using theater techniques to assist violence prevention, human rights, communication, consensus decision making, and peace building.
- Música infantil puertorriqueña.** This award to a music education non-profit preserved a historic collection of songs published in two volumes (1901 & 1904) and taught in schools. Unavailable to teachers for decades, the project's website offers free access to song lyrics, music tracks, and an educator's guide.
